Dear Client,

Please be advised of some changes to our service framework which will progressively come into effect over the next month. Moving forward we will focus on the service between Asia and the Melanesian ports in Papua New Guinea, Vanuatu and the Solomon Islands. Our services with Fiji, New Zealand and Australia will be suspended indefinitely.

The revised direct port coverage will be:

***Port Kelang – Singapore – Port Moresby – Lae – Port Vila (\*) – Santo – Honiara – Noro (\*) – Rabaul – Madang – Philippines – Port Kelang \* Alternate calls***

We continue to offer an extensive transshipment service from a multitude of Asian ports.

The Pac Antlia V121110 / 111112 will be the last voyage to complete our current full rotation, and as such will be the last vessel to call into New Zealand and Australia.

The Turtle Bay 121111 / 111113, Pac Aquila 121112 / 111114, and Pac Antlia 121113 / 111115 **will continue with their current schedule up to and including Suva**, after which they will phase into the new schedule.

Sailing frequency into Vanuatu and the Solomon Islands will improve considerably as summarised below, and to Papua New Guinea our current 19 day service frequency remains unchanged.
